RCG IT Project Wins 2005 InfoWorld 100 Award

Award honors 100 Most Creative and Cutting-Edge Implementations of Enterprise Technology

Edison, NJ, March 9, 2006 – RCG Information Technology (www.rcgit.com) proudly recognizes its client Suffolk County for being named a 2005 winner of the prestigious *InfoWorld 100* award. Suffolk County was one of only five government organizations to be honored with this award for its *Virtual County Clerk's Office*. The criteria for the award included projects that used multiple cutting-edge technologies in innovative ways to serve well-defined business goals. InfoWorld is an industry-leading publication focused on IT emerging technologies and products.

The Suffolk County project was honored in the Enterprise Content Management Solution category. Suffolk County is the first county in the nation to open online subscriber access to its massive land records, giving constituents a self-service option any time of the day or night. The system will allow subscribers to extract high-level information through data mining technology instead of relying on third parties to essentially provide the same service.

Spearheaded by its Long Island office in Uniondale, NY, RCG IT competed with several local firms for Suffolk County's contract and was chosen for the comprehensiveness of its vision and solution. RCG IT designed, developed and deployed a Microsoft® .NET based application that offers Suffolk County and constituents advanced self-service capabilities to search mortgages, deeds, liens, UCCs, judgments and civil court actions, viewing of indexed information, viewing, downloading and printing scanned images of original documents, online paying and billing, and much more.

The Virtual Suffolk County Clerk's Office was also recognized by RCG IT with its 2006 delivery excellence award. The project was instrumental in reducing overall process cost associated with County operations. Suffolk County will generate \$1.5 million of new incremental annual revenues which will pay for their entire implementation investment in seven months.

“We commend Suffolk County for winning this award. It was a visionary move from the County’s Director of Information Technology,” says Rob Simplot, president and CEO of RCG IT. “What he didn’t expect was to create such a significant revenue stream for the County and get a return on the investment in such a short time.
